

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

## Our Philosophy

People suffer emotionally in many ways. They demonstrate feelings, thoughts and behaviors in different and unique ways. Occasional problems are not cause for alarm, but when people of any age show increased levels of unhappiness, anger, aggression or ongoing difficulty in getting along with others, they may need help. Dramatic personality changes or prolonged negative moods and behaviors often are indicative of a need for assistance to achieve new coping and problem-solving skills.



Solutions vary for different people, but mental health treatment services can make a difference. Acacia's services are based on respect, and intended to empower clients and their families.

Acacia Clinic supports diversity in lifestyles and cultures. We promote the client's right to self-determination and participation in goal-setting to develop a treatment plan. The therapeutic process assists clients in identifying problems and seeking options to resolve psychological, medical, educational and spiritual issues. We offer clients tools and resources for coping and solving problems in life. We integrate solution-focused, cognitive-behavioral and bio-psycho-social approaches for healing and recovery.

## Services for Adults and Families

- \* Psychotherapy, Counseling and Psychological testing for mental health and AODA issues
- \* Psychiatric Assessments, Medication management and Referrals
- \* Assessment for urgent or emergency clients (those in crisis, immediate danger of harming self/others)
  - \* Those recently discharged from a hospital for transition back to home
  - \* Those in emotional distress due to a serious life experience or events
  - \* Those with a serious mental illness requiring active, ongoing support and monitoring
- \* In-home therapy for adults who cannot attend sessions at an office, with brief In-home services (averaging 12 sessions)
- \* Helping family members support those in emotional distress or who need assistance
- \* Case management for clients and their family and referrals to obtain other resources/services
- \* Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse Services for dually-diagnosed disorders (MH issues and alcoholism, drug dependence, smoking, eating disorders): Assessment, Education, Counseling and Relapse-prevention.

## Services for Children, Youth & Parents

- \* Pre-school Assessment Consultation Service provides support to child care providers and families of children 2-6 years of age
  - \* Individual and family therapy to assist families in which one or more child is exhibiting difficulties such as: *Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), Oppositional Defiance Disorder (ODD), Mood disorders (including anxiety and depression), and Post-traumatic Stress Disorders (PTSD)* and /or other childhood psychiatric disorders
- \* Intensive In-home Services for severely emotionally disturbed (SED) children
  - \* Parenting Assistance and Supervision for home management, and Parenting Skills Training.
